The Horizons Summer Program returns to St. Catherine-St. Lucy School for the third summer! The program is open to preschool through 7th grade students. Horizons@SCSL begins Monday, June 16, 2025 and concludes Friday, July 26, 2025 (no program on June 19th and July 4th). Program hours are from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The program can accommodate up to 90 participants.

Academics and Enrichment

- Academic classes occur Monday-Thursday and include Reading, Writing, Math, and STEM.
 Enrichment activities include Sports, Art and Social Emotional Learning (SEL).
- Small classroom sizes will be maintained to allow instructors to provide more individualized attention to students.
- Field trips are held each Friday. Trips include the Museum of Science & Industry, bowling, and the zoo. Parents are welcome to volunteer as chaperones.
- Swimming lessons will be held twice and are required for all K-7th grade participants. Swimsuits
 and goggles are required.

Academic Assessments

- The STAR pre- and post-assessment will be utilized as a tool to ensure personalized instruction in Reading and Math.
- To ensure STAR testing IDs are available to each program participant, registration WILL NOT be
 permitted after May 30, 2025. The pre-assessments will take place on the first day of the
 program, Monday, June 16, 2025. Post testing will take place July 23-24, 2025. While we expect
 high attendance, it is crucial that all participants take both the pre- and post-tests to ensure the
 program can effectively assess its impact on students.

Program and Program Fees

- Students are expected to attend for the entire duration of the program. Exceptions may be made for family vacations; however, participants are required to attend a minimum of 26 days.
- The program registration fee is \$50. Cost is \$100/week for one participant and \$150/week for two or more participants. We ask that all families apply for CCAP as a method of payment for the program. Families that do not meet CCAP eligibility standards may be eligible for scholarships from the Horizons National Chicago Region.
- Extended Care is available from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for an additional charge of \$25 per week.
 Please send a snack with Extended Care participants. Be sure to sign up for Extended Care when registering for the program.
